**Re: Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Lincoln Park Grid Support Center
Status Update**

Dear Supervisor Quigley and Members of the Town of Ulster Town Board,

As you know, GlidePath Development LLC on behalf of its subsidiary Lincoln Park DG LLC (the “Applicant”) has been diligently working to prepare the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (“DEIS”) for the Lincoln Park Grid Support Center (the “Project”) based on the Final Scope approved by the Town of Ulster acting as Lead Agency (the “Town”) pursuant to Part 617.8 of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”).

We write today to inform the Town that the DEIS for the Project will not be completed until the First Quarter of 2019. Though we had originally anticipated submitting the DEIS by the end of 2018, the work of fully analyzing the various alternatives, as required by the Final Scope, has caused us to extend the timeline. GlidePath anticipates submitting the DEIS during the First Quarter of 2019.
